## FROM THE PRESIDENT

The new five-ton digger has arrived and is now helping to improve our course. It has cleared many of the drains along 3 & 8 fairways and behind the 7th tee. It has also been very useful holding the large pine by 10 ladies' tee while rings were being cut ready for firewood splitting. The digger is housed under cover by the fire burning area. To date we have had donations of money for our digger totaling \$1 200.

Firewood sales are steady, about 4/5 loads per week. We still have trees to ring and split and to recover at the end of Tairua Heights Road. A special mention to the men who cut down these trees, cut them into rings ready for splitting and then deliver trailer loads of wood to our clients. This is a very good money earner for our Club.

Our golf carts are becoming more popular with our members and visitors. The renewal of the cart lease is coming up in Sep/Oct. We will be looking at a deal that is suitable for our members.

A group of ladies have done a great job of upgrading the gardens especially around the bowling green making this a much tidier place for campers.

The greens are in great condition after the recent coring. This will help to keep our greens in good condition as we move into winter. From now on the weather will dictate what we can achieve on the golf course. The dredgings will be very useful for our tracks and other low lying levels of our course.

Unfortunately, Doug Hayward has had to resign from the Board. In terms of the Constitution with the resignation of a Board member the vacancy can be filled as
