## KITCHEN/CATERING REPORT

The kitchen is operating smoothly with the four teams working in rotation to provide for the catering needs of the club. As well as regular bar snacks on club days and Coffee Club on Tuesdays, during May we have catered for the 9 Hole Pennants Tournament and the Open 9 Hole Tournament making a good profit on all events. Coming up next is a planned fund-raising event, the mid-winter Christmas Dinner on June 12th for which 60 tickets are available.

During the month Jan Collier and Jenny Chalmers have been reviewing the kitchen income and expenditure records for this financial year and separating them from tournament income so that we have a clearer idea of overall kitchen costs, income, and profit. For the period from mid-October to the end of April a preliminary summary of financial transactions involving the kitchen indicates a gross income of around \$7481.00 with costs of \$2,748.00 producing a profit for the kitchen of approximately \$4,733.00. This has been made possible by the voluntary assistance provided by the kitchen teams. A very worthwhile effort.
