

KITCHEN/CATERING REPORT

Kitchen Convenor.

The kitchen has continued operating during October despite some limitations imposed by Covid and the cancellation of the Melanion Labour Weekend Tournament due to bad weather. The major pre-occupation of the Kitchen Committee has been finding a new Kitchen Co-ordinator. With Jenny Chalmers, Robyn Hunter and Shirley Fellows retiring for health reasons at the AGM, no golfers have offered to take up the position of convenor or to lead one of the catering teams. The only person able to continue on the committee is Margaret Wallace who cannot manage the task on her own. It will be up to golfers to find a solution, or the kitchen will need to close because we are not only short of volunteers, but the work required to get and maintain compliance with Food Processing and Health and Safety regulations is complex and time consuming. Our recent TCDC inspection achieved certification for the Club but there were several detailed aspects of food processing, temperature monitoring, record keeping, cleaning and maintenance where we were judged to be non-conforming and were asked to provide more evidence that we complied with standards as specified on the government food processing web site. Some of this is very technical and other areas relate to our aging facilities.

Going forward, if the club wants to continue cooking for tournaments, scrambles, and other events where food is prepared in the kitchen (including by a caterer) a new committee must be formed to oversee and co-ordinate kitchen operations. This needs to happen now because there should be a hand over period where the new team has the opportunity to benefit from the experience of the outgoing committee who retire in less than a month.

Coffee Club.

After hibernation during level 4 lockdown the Coffee Club is up and running again every Tuesday at 10.00am. It is an informal social get together for members and their friends especially targeted at those who no longer play golf. However on wet days golfing members are welcome to join in. It is a chance to meet up with old and new friends and keep up with club news. The cost each week is \$3.00 with any profits going towards kitchen maintenance and equipment.
